# Dress Code Guidelines

- ▶ Black, White, Gray or Teal Polo with School logo must be worn everyday

### TOPS



**Uniform Polo with Logo**

Approved Colors: white, black, gray, teal



**CRHS Sweatshirts/Jackets**

Coral Reef Hoodie or sweatshirt ONLY; (School colors M-Th)

Must have school polo underneath M-



**SPIRIT Shirt/Jacket ONLY FRIDAY**

Only a Coral Reef Spirit Shirt



No other Logo (including others schools or teams) on Sweatshirts, sweaters, hoodies, or shirts



No garments exposing midriffs  
No tied or cut shirts/sweaters/jackets

### BOTTOMS



**Approved Bottoms:**

Any color pants, jeans (no rips), sweatpants, joggers (adidas pants), knee length shorts, knee length skirts for all students



**NOT Approved Bottoms:**

Spandex (shorts), leggings, sheer material, pajama pants, short shorts, ripped jeans, no stockings or visible undergarments



# ***All Senior obligations must be cleared by December 1<sup>st</sup>***

Financial obligations all paid and cleared per treasurer.

- Club and Athletic obligations cleared.
- Community Service completed, input into the system and your counselor has cleared you.

May not have 10 or more unexcused absences or 20 or more unexcused tardies

Seniors must be present at school to participate in any senior event

No Senior Year Suspensions

All detentions must be served

Valid school ID must be shown to purchase ticket and shown on day of the event

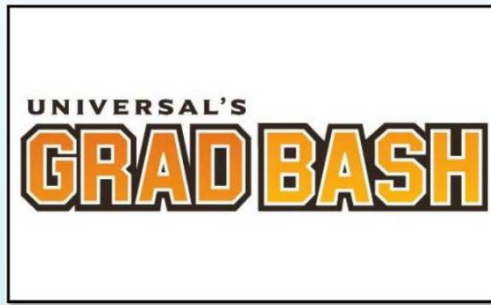

# Grad Bash Day!!!!

- ▶ Students must arrive at school by 7:20 am.
- ▶ Students do not have to arrive in uniform but must wear and show their **Coral Reef ID**.
- ▶ No extra bags or coolers allowed to Grad Bash. Small bag is allowed and will be searched before loading the bus.
- ▶ Seniors will be given a light breakfast in the morning before loading buses
- ▶ No food or drinks allowed in the bus leaving Coral Reef. Water will be provided for each student
- ▶ K-9 Police Dogs will be assisting with the search that morning.

# DRESS CODE

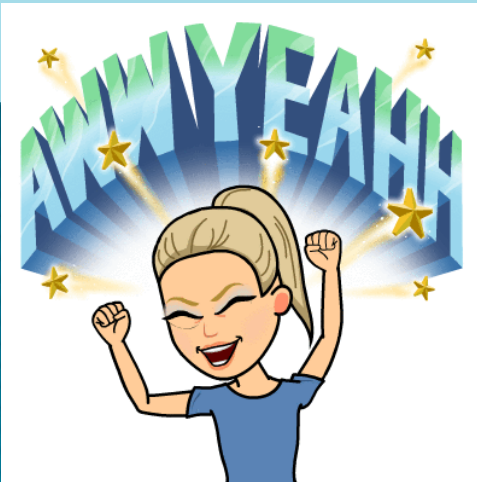
