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Admission's Policy

Coral Reef Senior High School follows the Miami-Dade Public Schools designated policy for admissions into a magnet program, any revisions to this policy are mandated by the School District.

Coral Reef is an all-magnet school that offers six specific magnet programs, the International Baccalaureate Program being one of them. All students are required to complete an online application through the Magnet Office (Schools of Choice) for Miami-Dade County. Students may apply to five schools on the application and are chosen based on a random selection process, apart from the performing arts magnet. Students must meet minimum GPA, Conduct, and Attendance requirements to be eligible for all programs. The IB Programme requires additional course completion consisting of Honors Algebra 1 and Honors Physical Science, along with its individual GPA, Conduct, and Attendance requirements. If the applicant is deemed eligible and has a sibling who will continue to be in attendance the following school year, they are given priority to be admitted to Coral Reef. Students with parents who are active military, who meet eligibility requirements, are given automatic acceptance. Additionally, Coral Reef has a Memorandum of Understanding with the German Federation for students who are enrolled in the German International Studies Language Magnet Program at Carver Middle School that allows them direct articulation into our German International Studies Program upon meeting all eligibility requirements.

Coral Reef's admission's policy is reviewed and communicated through the Magnet School of Choice application website, our school's website, and is shared with families in our many recruiting efforts throughout the county on a yearly basis. This policy was last reviewed during summer of 2025.
